Income-Based Scholarships

Two income-based scholarships are available: the **Florida Tax Credit Scholarship** and **Family Empowerment Scholarship**. Both scholarships give students an option to find the best schools to meet their K-12 learning needs. Please review the income guidelines to see if your family qualifies.

Special Needs Scholarship

The **Gardiner Scholarship** helps Florida families customize education for their children with certain special needs who are ages 3 through 22. The scholarship includes 17 diagnoses, including autism spectrum disorder, anaphylaxis and intellectual disability. Parents can use scholarship money toward a combination of approved programs and providers that best meet their children's unique learning needs.
